

Guidelines for Completion of the Ph.D. Degree in Graduate in Institute of Information and Computer Education (Draft)

- I. Students entering our department have to complete at least 24 credits of professional and specialty courses (not excluding Independent Study, Seminar, Selective Readings in Information and Computer Education and thesis).
- II. Required Courses :
 1. Seminar (I, II, III, IV total 4 credits.)
 2. Independent Study (Every semester.)
 3. Thesis (After pass the Qualify Exam)
- III. Prepare Courses :
 1. Educational Psychology and Educational Statistics. (The credits have to exclude from the graduate credits.)
 2. Research Methods in Information and Computer Education and Advanced Applied Statistics. (The credits can be count into graduate credits.)
- IV. Thesis Advisors
Thesis advisors can be selected from any assistant professors or above who is a member of our institute.
- V. Studies Status Condition check
Every Ph.D. student has to pass two times Ph.D. studies condition check. (Please read the rule of condition check.)
- VI. Qualify Examination
Student who wants to apply Qualify Exam has to pass two times studies condition check. And students have to publish one paper which has to match the requirement of department rules.
- VII. Research project examination
After Qualify Exam, student has to apply Research project examination.
- VIII. Degree Examination
After 4 months for passing the Qualify Exam, student who can apply the degree examination.
