

Guidelines for Completion of the Master Degree in Graduate in Institute of Information and Computer Education (Draft)

- I. Students entering our department have to complete at least 28 credits of professional and specialty courses (not excluding Directed Study I and II and Statistical Data Analysis and Processing).
- II. Required Courses :
 1. Research Methods in Information and Computer Education
 2. Advanced Applied Statistics
 3. Seminar
 4. Directed Study
 5. Thesis
- III. Prepare Courses :

Students who have to pass these courses in college or other graduate school before him/her entering our department.

 1. Educational Psychology
 2. Educational Statistics

Above tow courses can be repair after entering the department, however the credits can not be include in graduate credits.
- IV. Credits Wave
Student who can apply credits wave which credits is from other graduate school, but can not apply more than 9 credits.
- V. Every course selection has to approve by thesis adviser.
